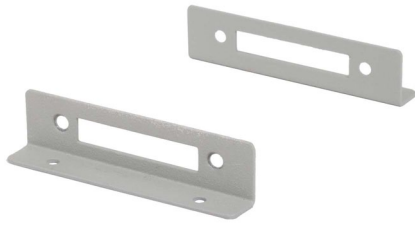


iConverter[®] Wall Mount Bracket User Manual

Product Overview

The 8249-0 iConverter Wall-Mounting kit was designed to attach one iConverter 1-Module or 2-Module chassis to a wall, rack or other flat surface.



Unpacking, Visual Inspection and Inventory

The 8249-0 kit should include the following hardware:

- 2x “L” shaped brackets
- 4x Flat head screws, 4-40, 1/4 inch
- 4x Wall mounting screws
- 1x User Manual

Inspect equipment and immediately report any damage or discrepancies to Omnitron at 949-250-6510. If equipment is damaged, do not apply power to the equipment.

Warning:

Before installing the brackets on an iConverter chassis, make sure to remove it from its power adapter. Make sure to disconnect the power adapter from the AC line power.

Installing the Mounting Bracket

Align the screw threads of the iConverter chassis with the holes in the bracket.

Attach one “L” bracket on each side of the unit using the 4-40 flat head screws enclosed with the kit.

The chassis with the brackets installed will look like the picture below.



Wall and Rack Mounting

The 1-Module and 2-Module chassis can be wall/rack mounted by attaching the wall mount brackets as shown on the previous page.

A 19” Rack Mount Shelf (8260-0) is available to install three 1-Module chassis or two 2-Module chassis.

Consult the User Manual for the installed module for installation and configuration information.
