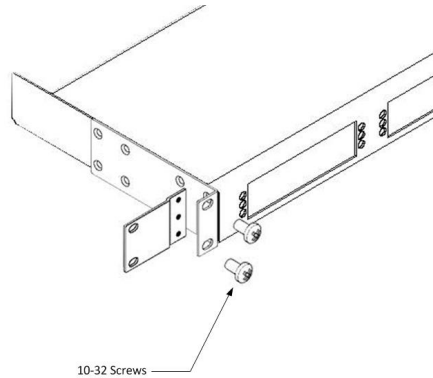


Description

The 23" Rack Mount Extender, model number 5800-20, allows the OmniLight 14 Module Chassis and 3-Module Shelf to be installed in a 23" equipment rack.

Installation Procedure

Install the rack mount extender brackets to the existing mounting bracket as shown in the diagram. Install the extender bracket on both sides using the 10-32 screws.
